The plaintiffs, who were brother and sister, sued their sister for undue influence arising from their being disinherited from their mother's will.

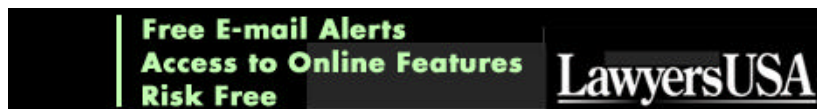
